Directions:

FROM ROCKLAND: Take NYS Thruway southbound to Tappan Zee Bridge. Take second exit after bridge, Exit 8A, Saw Mill River Parkway North. Continue on Saw Mill to Exit 32 (Chappaqua-Route 120). At end of exit ramp turn left under bridge. At traffic light, make another left onto Route 120 and go over bridge, bear right at fork. Turn right at stop sign (So. Greeley Ave.) and continue for 1/4 mile to Route 117. Turn left (north on Route 117). Temple is approximately 1/4 mile on the left side.

FROM CONNECTICUT Follow I-95 South to New York State Exit 21. Follow 287 West to I-684 North. Get off at Exit 2 (Airport). Go right at stop sign at end of exit, turn left at the traffic light onto Route 120. Continue on Route 120 approximately 2 miles where it will intersect with Route 22, merge to left lane. At traffic light make left turn (Route 120). Stay on Route 120 approximately 4 1/2 miles to Route 117. Turn left on Route 117 (going south). Temple is 4/10th of a mile on the right side.
