(#1) – Technical and Financial Assistance for Green Building: Craig Kneeland, LEED AP Senior Project Manager NYS Energy Research and Development Authority.

The presentation will cover NYSERDA's technical and financial assistance for green building projects. It will also include examples of some of our green building projects around New York State.

(#2) – Wood Doors: Rob Ziegelmeier Ideal Architectural Doors & Plywood

This program reviews the Architectural Woodwork Institute Quality Standards and discusses the differences between the three quality grades (Premium, Custom & Economy). The program also addresses the contrasts between AWI and WDMA specifications. It will touch on such other issues as face quality, veneer lay-up and positive pressure fire doors.

(#3) – Lighting Design Process for Interior Applications: Steven Mesh, IES, IALD Holophane Co.

Attendees will learn about: What to light; Appropriate lighting levels; How to take into account lighting distribution, lamping, and limitations of a space; Using information from manufacturers to determine appropriate fixtures and fixture locations; Determine an effective lighting scheme. Using computer programs to predict lighting levels and effects. Verifying code compliance with ASHRAE 90.1 energy standards; Evaluate different lighting schemes for a given space; Misc. lighting design issues.

(#4) – Energy Performance: Pete O'Connor C.S.I. Black Millwork Co.

The presentation will demonstrate the two-tiered approach to energy performance in regards to windows and doors. Living in a temperate weather region, these products have to address both solar heat gain in the summer and cold infiltration in the winter. Topics also covered pertain to the energy code requirements and the ways to comply. The science of the sun is also addressed.
